Sunflower Competition Under way.

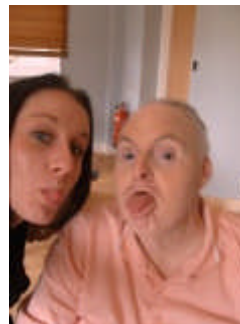
